SCRIPTURE

Luke 12

Take your time, and write down what stands out to you.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. The message opened by talking about the instability we often see in the world. When you hear troubling news or experience uncertainty in your own life, what is your natural response? How does remembering that God is sovereign change the way we respond?
2. Jesus warns in Luke 12:15 to “be on guard against all covetousness.” Why do you think the pull toward finding life or security in possessions can be so subtle?
3. In the parable of the rich fool, the man’s problem was not that he had abundance but that he was “rich toward himself and poor toward God.” What might that look like in everyday life today?
4. The teaching said “Possessions make a terrible savior.” In what ways do people today try to use money, success, or possessions to give them security or identity?
5. Jesus connects generosity and anxiety when He tells His disciples not to worry about tomorrow (Luke 12:22-31). How have you seen fear or anxiety affect your willingness to be generous?
6. Jesus says, “Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also” (Luke 12:34). What are some practical ways we can intentionally invest our treasure in things that last for eternity?
7. The message ended with the call to stay ready and live faithfully while we wait for Jesus to return. What is one step you feel God inviting you to take this week with your time, talents, or treasure?
