Welcome Lunch | October 9

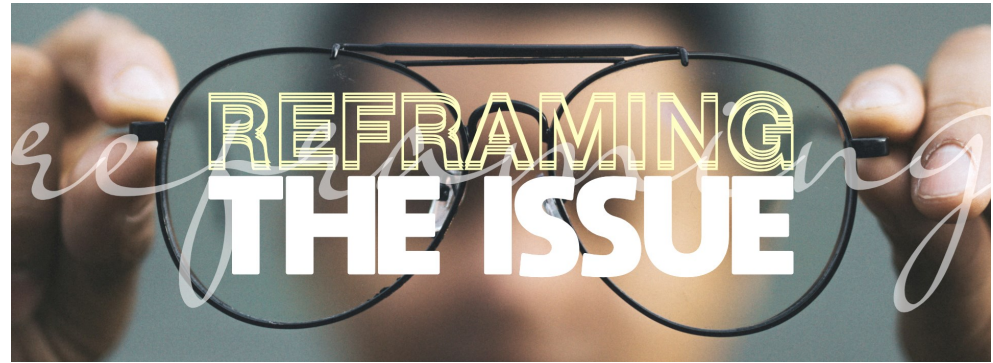
