By the mercies of God... let love be without hypocrisy. (v. 1, 9)

- 1. Speak WELL of people that don't speak well of you. (v. 14)
- Share in someone else's <u>WINS</u> and <u>LOSSES</u> like they are your own.
  (v. 15)
- 3. See others as ABOVE you rather than BENEATH you. (v. 16)
- 4. Stop and THINK before you REACT. (v. 17)

- 6. Stay out of the JUDGMENT seat by being KIND. (v. 19-21)
