### REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. When have you felt like God delayed in answering your prayers? How did that shape your trust in Him?
2. Martha and Mary both expressed faith and frustration to Jesus. How does their honesty encourage you to bring your full self to Him?
3. What does it mean to you that "Jesus wept"? How does this affect the way you see His compassion?
4. Jesus declares, "I am the resurrection and the life." How does this truth give you hope in both present struggles and future promises?
5. Where in your life do you feel something is "too far gone"? What might it look like to invite Jesus to bring new life there?
6. How does seeing Jesus' authority over death expand your understanding of who He is?
7. How can you live differently knowing the resurrection is not just a future hope but a present reality?
