Rewired Week 3: Simplicity

SCRIPTURE

Read: Luke 12:13–34, Psalm 23, and Colossians 1:15–17

Take your time, and write down what stands out to you.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **What external complexities are most weighing on your life right now?** How do these pressures shape the pace and priorities of your everyday decisions?
- **Where do you tend to look for your identity?** Are you trying to define who you are by what you do, what you feel, or how others perceive you?
- **Are your desires leading you into clarity or confusion?** Which of your desires are currently in conflict with each other? What does this reveal about what's at the center of your life?
- **What is your anxiety trying to tell you?** Could it be an invitation to reorder your values around the kingdom of God?
- **Where might you be tempted to believe "more" will bring peace?** Like the man in Jesus' parable, are you hoping that having more (possessions, control, affirmation) will solve an inner restlessness?
- **What would change if Jesus was truly at the center of your life?** How would your time, money, attention, and energy look different if they flowed from that center?
- **What does contentment look like for you this week?** What would it look like to "lie down in green pastures" (Psalm 23) even when surrounded by opportunity, pressure, or noise?

PRACTICE SIMPLICITY

Write down your answers in a personal journal or notes:

- **What's been dominating my thoughts this week?** (Work? Fear? Image? Finances? Injustice?)
- **What have I been looking to for peace or identity?** (Success? Control? Achievement? Others' approval?)
- **What would it look like to place Christ at the center instead?** (What truth do I need to remind myself of? What practice might help?)
