Rewired Week 4: Service

WEEKLY SCRIPTURE

Read: Luke 12:13–34, Psalm 23, and Colossians 1:15–17

Take your time, and write down what stands out to you.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Jesus emptied Himself (Philippians 2:5–7) — What pride or privilege am I being called to lay down so that I can serve like Jesus?
- Jesus obeyed the Father (Philippians 2:8) — Where is God asking me to obey, even when it costs me something?
- Jesus is exalted as Lord (Philippians 2:9–11) — How can I make sure my ministry points to Jesus' greatness instead of my own?
- When have I seen humility and selflessness in someone else's life inspire me to follow Christ more closely?
- How does surrendering my preferences in ministry (preaching, leading, or serving) help build unity in the body of Christ?
- Who is one person I can serve this week—not for recognition, but to advance God's mission?
- What is one simple way I can practice humility in my daily life outside of "formal ministry" (home, work, school, friendships)?

PRACTICE SERVICE

This week, let Philippians 2:5 be your compass: "Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus.

"Choose one intentional act of humble, sacrificial service—at Grace, in your home, at work, or at school.

Do it quietly, without recognition, as both your obedience and your witness that **Jesus is Lord**.
