SCRIPTURE

Read Matthew 6:19–34

Take your time, and write down what stands out to you.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What does my current relationship with money reveal about what I truly believe about Jesus—His security, His wisdom, and His leadership over my life?

Believing in Jesus means trusting that His way of treasure is actually better.

2. When Jesus says that “where your treasure is, your heart will be also,” do I believe Him enough to let my giving shape the direction of my heart?

Believing in Jesus means trusting that generosity forms us, not empties us.

3. Do I believe that my Father is faithful enough to provide for my needs if I release control, or do my habits with money show that I trust myself more than Him?

Believing in Jesus means trusting His care more than my fear.

4. When Jesus says, “Seek first the Kingdom,” do I believe He will take responsibility for the rest of my life, or do I still try to manage outcomes on my own?

Believing in Jesus means trusting His promise before I see His provision.

5. What step of generosity is Jesus inviting me to take that would require actual faith—not comfort, not convenience, but belief that He is who He says He is?

Believing in Jesus means trusting Him enough to act.
