### SCRIPTURE

Read Hebrews 12:1-2, 1 John 2:15-16

*Take your time, and write down what stands out to you.*

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1.** When you look back over this past year, how have you been “reading” your life more often: God is nowhere or God is now here? What moments shaped that reading?
- 2.** Where has pain, disappointment, or confusion tempted you to interpret your story through fear rather than faith? What would it look like to re-read that season with Jesus at the center?
- 3.** Who are the people, past or present, whose lives of faith encourage you to keep running when you feel weary? How does remembering their faith strengthen your own?
- 4.** What “encumbrances” or distractions have slowed your spiritual pace this year? Even if they are not sinful, how might they be keeping you from running well?
- 5.** Is there a specific area of unbelief or disobedience that has entangled you and broken your stride? What step of repentance or trust is God inviting you to take?
- 6.** Where has your focus drifted during the race—toward yourself, others, or circumstances—rather than staying fixed on Jesus? What would help you refocus your eyes on Him?
- 7.** As you look ahead to the year to come, what does it mean for you personally to run with endurance and finish well? How might linking arms with others in a faith group help you do that?
