DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1.** Where have you been tempted to interpret your life as random or chaotic rather than rooted in God's calling and foreknowledge? What would change if you truly believed you are chosen and known?
- 2.** How do you typically define hope in your own life—optimism, circumstances, outcomes, or a living Person? In what ways does the resurrection of Jesus reshape your understanding of hope?
- 3.** What fears or insecurities cause you to live as if your salvation depends on your performance rather than God's power? How might trusting that God is holding you bring rest?
- 4.** What current trial or season of pain feels most confusing or heavy right now? How could God be using this suffering to refine and strengthen your faith rather than remove it?
- 5.** When pain enters your story, do you see it as evidence of God's absence or His ongoing work? What helps you remember that refinement is not abandonment?
- 6.** How does knowing that your life is part of God's long, unfolding story of salvation change the way you view your daily obedience, faithfulness, and perseverance?
- 7.** As you look ahead, what would it mean for you to live anchored in what Christ has done rather than defined by what has happened to you? What is one concrete step of faith God is inviting you to take?
