SCRIPTURE

1 Peter 2:13 – 3:7

Take your time, and write down what stands out to you.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Submission assumes trust. What does this teaching reveal about who Jesus is and why He is worthy of our obedience even when submission feels costly or confusing?
2. Peter says submission can be an act of worship. How does anchoring our lives in the gospel rather than politics or preferences reshape the way we respond to authority?
3. In Acts 4–5, Peter obeys God even when it leads to conflict. How do we discern the difference between faithful submission and faithful resistance, and why does staying close to Jesus matter in that tension?
4. Jesus submitted Himself even in injustice (1 Peter 2:21–25). Where in your life is God inviting you to adopt Christ's posture of willing, humble submission, not as weakness but as strength?
5. Peter frames submission as a witness. How might your response to unfairness or authority become a visible testimony that points others to Christ?
6. Ephesians emphasizes mutual submission out of reverence for Christ. How does mutual honor and generosity in relationships challenge cultural ideas of power, control, or entitlement?
7. If submission is a pathway into freedom, not the loss of it, what is one specific area this week where you can practice submission as an act of faith so others can more clearly see Jesus through you?
