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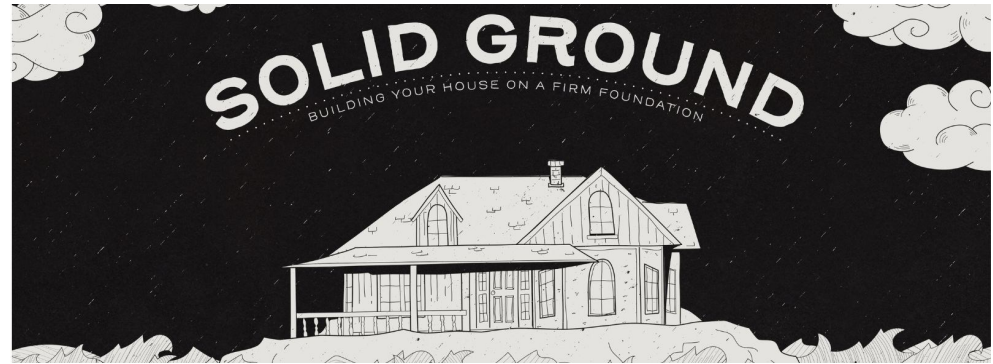

a. Focus on our ETERNAL triumph instead of our temporal trouble!
6. Be ENCOURAGING toward life's friends (v. 12-14):
a. Leave a legacy of HOPE rather than doubt!
