When suffering or pressure comes, do you interpret it as God damaging you or shaping you?
How does remembering your eternal destiny change how you see today’s struggle?

When people walk away from conversations with you, do they leave with more hope or more heaviness?

What would it look like to intentionally leave a trail of love and peace this week?
