SCRIPTURE

1 Peter 4:7-19

Take your time, and write down what stands out to you.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. When you hear the phrase “the end of all things is near,” what emotions or thoughts come up for you? How is Peter using this idea to shape how we live rather than to scare us?
2. Peter says being clear-minded and self-controlled helps our prayers (v.7). What are some distractions or pressures that make it hard for you to pray or focus on God right now?
3. Verse 8 says that love “covers a multitude of sins.” What do you think that means in everyday life? How can love help heal or protect relationships in a church or group?
4. Hospitality doesn’t just mean having people over for dinner. What are some simple ways someone new to faith could practice hospitality or kindness this week?
5. Peter says everyone has received a gift to serve others (v.10). What are some abilities or interests you already have that God might use to help or encourage someone else?
6. Peter says not to be surprised when following Jesus is hard. What are some challenges people might face today for being a Christian, and why do you think God says we don’t need to be ashamed?
7. In verse 19, believers are told to trust God and keep doing good even when life is difficult. What does trusting God look like in real life when things don’t make sense?
