### SCRIPTURE

Luke 14:12–24

*Take your time, and write down what stands out to you.*

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Where do you see yourself in this story right now? Are you assuming you're already "in," making excuses, feeling unworthy, or actively inviting others?
2. What "good things" in your life are quietly competing with your obedience to Jesus? Work, comfort, relationships, schedule... where might something good be becoming an excuse?
3. Have you ever assumed someone didn't belong at God's table? What shaped that assumption, and how does this passage challenge it?
4. Do you believe the invitation of Jesus is really for you? Where do you still feel unworthy, hesitant, or like you need to clean yourself up first?
5. Who is someone in your life that you've hesitated to invite into the life Jesus offers? What's holding you back... fear, discomfort, uncertainty?
6. If God's heart is to fill the house, how does that reshape how you see your role? Do you see yourself more as a guest... or as someone sent?
7. What would it look like this week to actively "compel" someone toward Jesus? Not pressure, but intentional love, conversation, and invitation.
