DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. When you think about your future or your career, what drives your imagination most — security, success, influence, impact, obedience, something else?
2. In what ways have you subtly assumed that your gifts and talents exist primarily to serve your own needs or desires?
3. Where might you be “conformed to the world” in how you think about success, platform, influence, or achievement?
4. If your body is the place where worship happens, what does your daily life actually say you worship — in your work, your time, your relationships, your habits?
5. Do you tend to define yourself more by your accomplishments or your failures? How would it change your self-understanding to root it instead in what Christ has done for you?
6. Are there gifts in others that you feel threatened by? What might that reveal about where you are still operating from comparison instead of shared mission?
7. What would it look like, practically, for you to place your gifts on the altar and ask:
“Jesus, how do You want to use this for Your redemptive mission?”
