Colossians 4:2-6, Acts 4:29-31

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why do you think people naturally share the things they believe are good news, yet often hesitate to talk about Jesus?
2. Paul asks for “open doors” instead of easy circumstances. What does that reveal about the way Christians should think about mission and daily life?
3. Who is someone in your life you could begin praying for consistently by name? What would it look like to pray for an open door with them?
4. In what ways can the way Christians live either build credibility for the gospel or create confusion about it?
5. What are some everyday spaces in your life where God may already be giving you opportunities to live as someone who is sent?
6. The message said, “Treat people like people, not projects.” Why is that important when talking about faith and spiritual conversations?
7. Which of these challenges feels most important for you this week: praying for open doors, living more intentionally, or speaking with more grace and truth?
